

Mothers suspect that toxic contamination caused their children's severe disabilities and sickness.

I've been there, and I spoke to one local leader who said, "We just want the world to know what is happening here." I talked to a mother, holding her paralyzed daughter, who said, "We have been forgotten."

Thanks to MADRE, I was able to say: "There are people who will send help and demand justice." I told them about all the MADRE members who have not forgotten them, who have formed a Haweeja Action Team.
